The Senior Members of the University shall move in procession, juniores priores, to their places in the Great Hall.

After which the Registrar, the Public Orator, the Deans of Faculties, the Vice-Chancellor, and the Chairman of the University Council shall conduct the Chancellor-Elect into the Great Hall.

The Vice-Chancellor shall then constitute the Congregation.

Then shall be sung Die Stem van Suid-Afrika.

UIT die blou van onse hemel,
Uit die diepte van ons see,
Oor ons ewige gebergtes
Waar die kranse antwoord gee,
Deur ons ver verlate vlaktes
Met die kreun van ossewa—
Ruis die stem van ons geliefde,
Van ons land SUID-AFRIKA.

Ons sal antwoord op jou roepstem,
Ons sal offer wat jy vra :
Ons sal lewe, ons sal sterwe,
Ons vir jou, SUID-AFRIKA.

The Congregation still standing, the Dean of Divinity shall say,

Let us pray.

O GOD, in whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge : We beseech thee to illuminate this our University with the light that cometh from thee ; that those who teach may be taught of thee, and those who learn may be led of thy spirit ; and grant that by the increase of knowledge thy truth may be confirmed, and thy glory shown forth ; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

O GOD, forasmuch as without thee we are not able to please thee : Mercifully grant that thy Holy Spirit may in all things direct and rule our hearts ; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

After which the Congregation shall be seated.

Then shall the Public Orator present WILLIAM JOHN BUSSCHAU to the Vice-Chancellor for the degree of Doctor of Laws, honoris causa. Thereafter the Vice-Chancellor shall confer the degree of Doctor of Laws upon WILLIAM JOHN BUSSCHAU.

Then shall the Chairman of the University Council present the Chancellor-Elect to the Vice-Chancellor, saying,

SIR, I present to you WILLIAM JOHN BUSSCHAU to be installed as Chancellor of this University.

Then shall the Vice-Chancellor say to the Chancellor-Elect,

SIR, it having pleased you to accept the invitation of the Council of the University to assume the office of Chancellor, I now require you to say after me these words following :

I, WILLIAM JOHN BUSSCHAU, Pledge myself To fulfil the duties of Chancellor of Rhodes University, As prescribed by Law, Without fear or favour As far as in me lies, And in all things to promote the welfare of the University.

After which he shall say,

SIR, on behalf of Rhodes University I now install you into the office of Chancellor, and invest you with the authority, rights and privileges appertaining thereto.

The Chancellor's academic gown having been removed, the Registrar shall invest the Chancellor with his gown of office.

After which, the Vice-Chancellor shall step down, and conduct the Chancellor to the Chair.

The Vice-Chancellor shall then present the Chancellor to the Congregation saying,

I PRESENT to you WILLIAM JOHN BUSSCHAU now installed as Chancellor of this University.

The Vice-Chancellor shall then invite the Chancellor to address the Congregation.

Thereafter the Chancellor shall dissolve the Congregation.

Then he and the Senior Members of the University shall leave the Great Hall, seniores priores, conducted by the Registrar.
